Who Must Attend?

By Local Rule of the Warren County Court of Common Pleas, Division of Domestic Relations, all parents with minor children age 16 and under who are parties to a divorce, dissolution, legal separation or by order of the presiding judge. Attendance is required prior to your first hearing.

Time

Two seminars will be held each month. A daytime and an evening session are available. Ask for the schedule when you call to pre-register.

Fee

The fee for the seminar is included in your court filing fee.

If you are attending post decree, your fee must be paid in advance and your receipt shown to be admitted to the class.

Pre-Registration

Pre-registration is required. Parents who have not pre-registered will not be admitted. Call the program office at Mental Health & Recovery Centers of Warren County for seminar dates and to pre-register. **Please give your court case number when you pre-register.** You and your child's other parent will need to pre-register separately.

Certificates of attendance will be given to participants who complete the entire session and the seminar evaluation forms. The program will notify the court of your attendance.
